The library of the TSWRDC W Mancherial is established in 2016 along with the institution with 3500 books. The activity of providing library facilities to the students and staff started along with the starting of academic programmes. The library is located in the ground floor of building I with stock and reading area. The library has collection of 10,451 volumes and 958 titles with 2000 reference books which covers the fields of Arts, Commerce, Sciences, computers and humanities. A separate collection is maintained for competitive exams. Every year new books will be added to the collection to fulfill Dr.S.R.Ranganathans fifth law Library is a growing organism.

Library subscribes to magazines and daily newspapers. Students are allowed to access the open access resources through the computer system available in the library.

The library is partially automated with **KOHA** library management software.

A library hour is conducted to the students as per the prescribed time table according to the time table a 150 students visits the library per day and a 10 number of teachers visits the library per day.

- 5. Circulation plays an important role in the library system. Students will be given textbooks before starting of semester and reference books for the purpose of assignments and seminars.


