Magnetic properties of matter arise from the alignment of atomic or molecular spins, generating magnetic fields. Materials exhibit varying degrees of magnetism: Ferromagnetism, paramagnetism, diamagnetism. These behaviors stem from interactions between magnetic moments, impacting material responses to external fields.

-> LASER is a device that emits light through a process of optical amplification based on the stimulated emission of electromagnetic radiation. LASERS produce coherent, monochromatic, collimated light that is useful for applications like barcodes, surgery, welding and fiber optics. LASER light is more powerful and focused than ordinary light.

-> The lack of electrical resistance in superconducting materials means that they can support high electrical currents without any energy loss due to resistance. This efficiency makes superconductors very attractive for power transmission.
