Social etiquette is a value-added course. Being conducted for undergraduate program, which is for 30 hours is being evaluated by the following evaluation procedure.

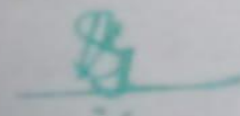
1. which includes group discussion as why etiquette is important



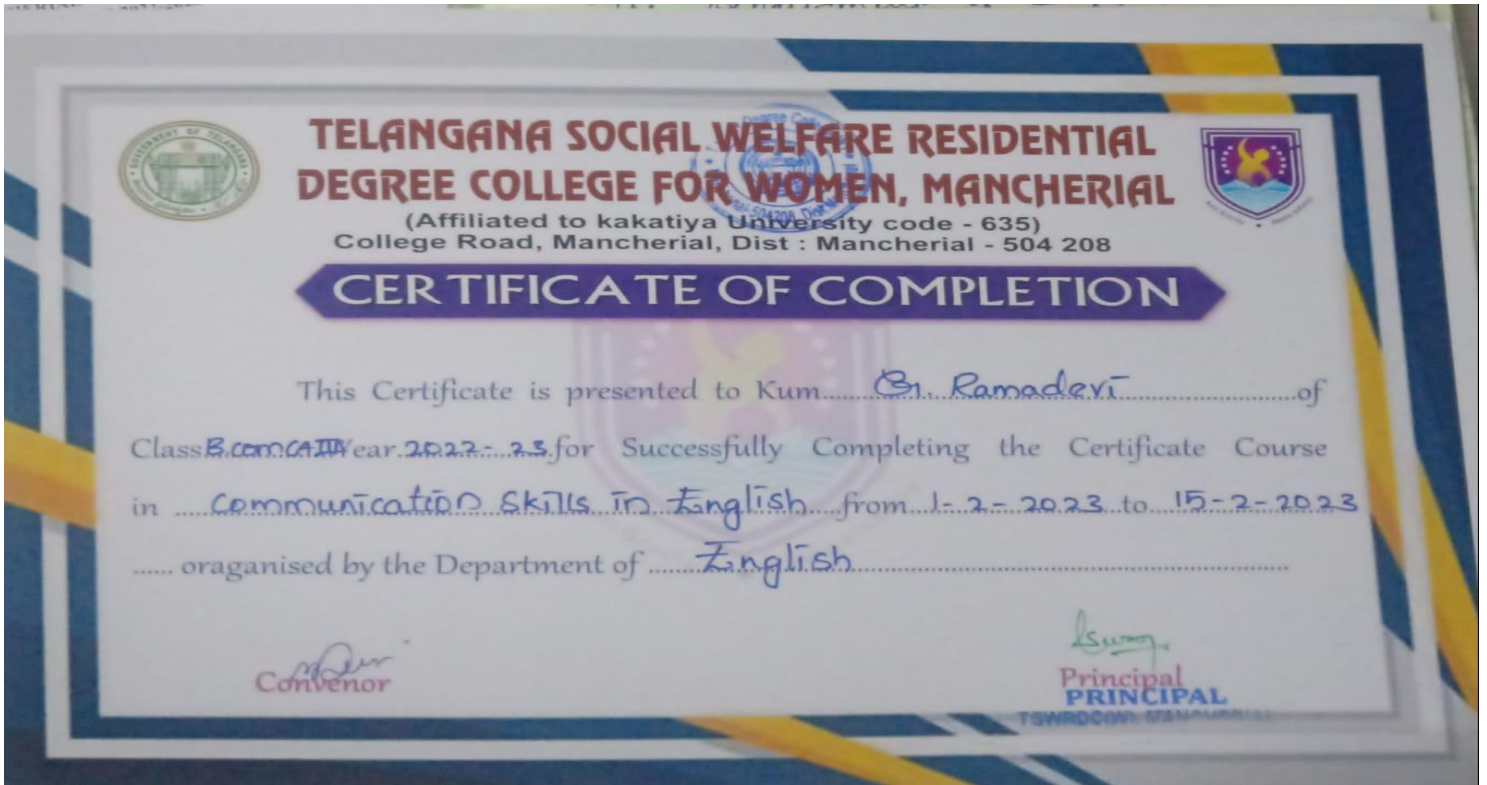
